Membership Guidelines and Registration Form

Who can join?

- Anyone who is age 28 years old and younger as of Jan 1st, 2019 (exceptions please email the conductor: amelyzhou@canadianchineseorchestra.com)
- Instruments such as Erhu, Pipa, Dizi, Yangqin, Guzheng, Zhongruan, Daruan, Cello, Suona, Sheng, and Chinese Percussions are welcome to audition
- Players who have had experiences learning the respective instruments and knows how to play D, C, G, Bflat and F key scales

How much does CYCO cost?

- **ADMIN FEE**: \$15.00 (First time applicant only)
- **REGISTRATION FEE**: \$180.00 each term (includes all costs associated with rehearsals, workshops, chamber music, and instructor fees) All touring and field trip is subject to a separate fee.

The CYCO is operated with two terms per year:

September - January (Fall Term) 180.00 \$ February - June (Winter Term) 180.00 \$

Late enrollment will be considered if there are at least 2/3 of term remaining. Registration fee will be paid in full.

Payment Options

- 1. Enclose one cheque for \$180.00 with your application. (payable to: *Hong Feng Canadian Chinese Orchestra*)
- 2. If you are paying in Cash, you can also hand it in on audition date September 8nd/15th

What does a CYCO audition entail?

Auditions are approximately 10 minutes long. In general, you can expect to be asked to play a 2 minute solo of your choice as well as perform the repertoire excerpts chosen by the music committee. You will be asked to play scales or sight read. You will be auditioning in front of a panel 2-3 people (CCO coach(es), other CCO musician(s), and/or CCO conductor).

Audition times are assigned once the registrations are processed.

Audition Date: September 8th/15th 3-6 PM

What is the time commitment for CYCO?

CYCO rehearsals generally take place between 3:15 PM to 5:00 PM on Sundays. In addition to weekly rehearsals, there are annual concert, community performances, and various workshops and extra rehearsals with guest conductors. A schedule of the full year will be provided at the first rehearsal and after that point CYCO members are required to check weekly emails throughout the season and note all schedule updates.

All CYCO members are strongly encouraged to continue their private music learning to ensure their progresses in orchestral playing.

During Rehearsals:

The following are a list of guidelines that we expect to be followed in order for the smooth and functional operation of the ensemble. We want to make the most of our time together. Please read the list carefully and sign the acknowledgment form page.

Rehearsal Rules:

- Please arrive 15 minutes early for each rehearsal so we may begin promptly and on time. Please use this window of time for tuning and setting up your space
- Rehearsal time is not practice time, we expect each member to come prepared and well practiced
- No food or drink are permitted within the practice space. Water with a tightly sealed lid is acceptable
- Please bring your own stand, music, instrument, and pencil
- Respect for the conductor is paramount. Any conversations of dire importance or if your neighbour needs assistance, please quietly excuse yourself so as to not disrupt the orchestra
- If you must leave before the end of rehearsal, it must be previously discussed and permitted by the conductor.



Absences:

- You're permitted 3 absences from rehearsal each year, any additional requires a doctors note or consent from the Conductor
- Soloists require a doctors note for all and any absences
- Please notify the conductor at least 24 hours prior to any absence
- Absenses which are excused from the above statements include: funeral services, school exams, and family emergencies.
- Attendances at Annual concerts and Performances are mandatory, for unforeseen circumstances member must provide formal written letter explaining the reasoning of absence.

Additional:

• Lost or damaged music will be replaced at Members own expense
